JLT Mobile Computers Interim Review January - June 2010

- Value of orders placed increased to SEK 50.5 million (36.1) – this is the third consecutive quarter with increased value of orders placed
- Net sales valued at SEK 36.7 million (40.1)
- Operating profit valued at SEK -4.1 million (- 3.0)
- Earnings per share valued at SEK -0.11 (- 0.06)
- An increase in sales is expected for the second half of 2010, which will provide a positive result for the year
- In July JLT received a SEK 35 million order for delivery before the end of 2010

Comments from CEO Per Holmberg:

“SEK 26.7 million of orders were placed during the second quarter. This is the third consecutive quarter in which we have seen an increase in orders. This gives an average quarter-to-quarter growth rate of 26 per cent for the last three quarters.”

“Strong growth in new orders on the US market continues and there has been a good recovery in JLT computer orders and sales in Europe, albeit from a previous low level.”

“As announced in the previous interim review, deliveries for the second quarter were affected by increased lead times for components and a weak order book at the beginning of the quarter. It resulted in a significant negative result for the second quarter.”

“In June, we launched new faster versions of the JLT1214 vehicle-mounted computer and the JLT8404 tablet PC. At the same time we launched a new Off-The-Shelf (OTS) Concept, enabling our customers to have immediate delivery of medium-sized volumes of product, which are available in several standard configurations. With these new models and the OTS Concept for rapid delivery, JLT is well positioned to meet customers' needs and take advantage of a recovering market.”



“In July we received a SEK 35 million order for delivery this year. With this large order, together with a strong order book going forward, we expect an increase in sales during the second half of 2010 and a positive result for the full year.”
